## AFTERSCHOOL SCHOOL AGE CRAFTS AND SCIENCE WEDNESDAYS

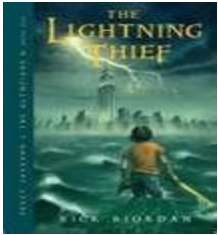
